Event Details

Saturday, June 1 - 9 AM to 1-2 PM

Meet up at Little Rainbow CR108 Trailhead

Join CCMR and SMT (Salida Mountain Trails) for a morning of trail stewardship. We are going to start work on a new trail - the Porter Gulch to Rainbow Trail connector. We will meet at the Little Rainbow trailhead on CR108, like we did last year. SMT will work on the Little Rainbow

Trail and CCMR will work on the new Porter Gulch connector. Moto riders may ride the Rainbow to Porter Gulch - about 15 miles of singletrack. Other CCMR volunteers will carpool up Howard Creek Road (CR4) to the Porter Gulch connector trailhead. We need to carpool as trailhead parking is limited.

Work planned is clearing and cutting a brand new 1/2-mile segment of new trail. It has been flagged. We will work until about 1 or 2 and then meet back at the Little Rainbow TH for lunch and drinks. Note: moto riders will need to ride back on the Rainbow as the new trail segment is not rideable. We will also provide tools but bring your backpack with any water and snacks that you may need.
